



## What is Learning Together?

Learning Together is a learning and support program for families with young children, aged from birth to preschool. The program includes:

- everyday learning
- time to play with your child
- support from early childhood teachers.

It's free or very low cost.

## What happens at Learning Together?

Each program is a little different, but always happens in a family-friendly space. There could be:

- playgroups
- playgroups just for babies (and their grown-ups)
- singing
- reading
- talking
- playing.

For you, there could also be:

- groups that focus on how your child learns
- the Circle of Security Parenting program
- opportunities to learn new skills, like cooking and nutrition.



## What will you get out of Learning Together?

You can:

- discover more about:
  - how your child learns
  - your child's behavior
  - ways to help your child learn
- go back to school, using SACE or TAFE, and connect what you learn with your family life
- ask all those questions you've always wanted to ask
- meet other families in your community
- connect to early childhood and other specialists
- experience a culture of inclusiveness.

## What will your child get out of Learning Together?

Children are learning from the moment they are born. Your role as parent or carer is central to helping your child learn.

With the help of early childhood educators, your child could be:

- having fun with you
- meeting new friends
- singing, reading and playing
- developing learning skills
- becoming confident and independent.
